GOSPEL READING: Luke 10:25-37

²⁵Just then a lawyer stood up to test Jesus. "Teacher," he said, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?" ²⁶He said to him, "What is written in the law? What do you read there?" ²⁷He answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." ²⁸And he said to him. "You have given the right answer: do this, and you will live." ²⁹But wanting to justify himself, he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" 30 Jesus replied.
